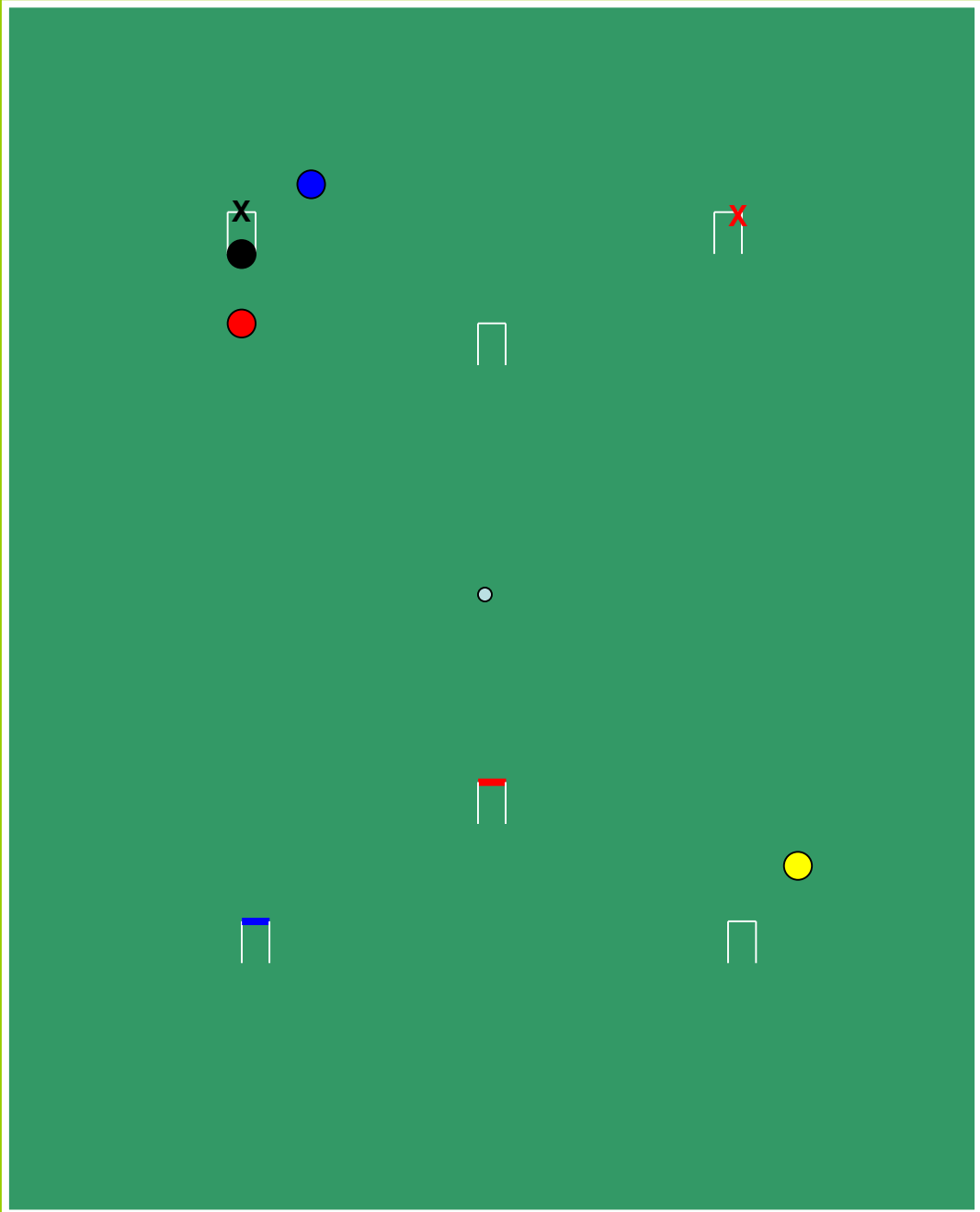
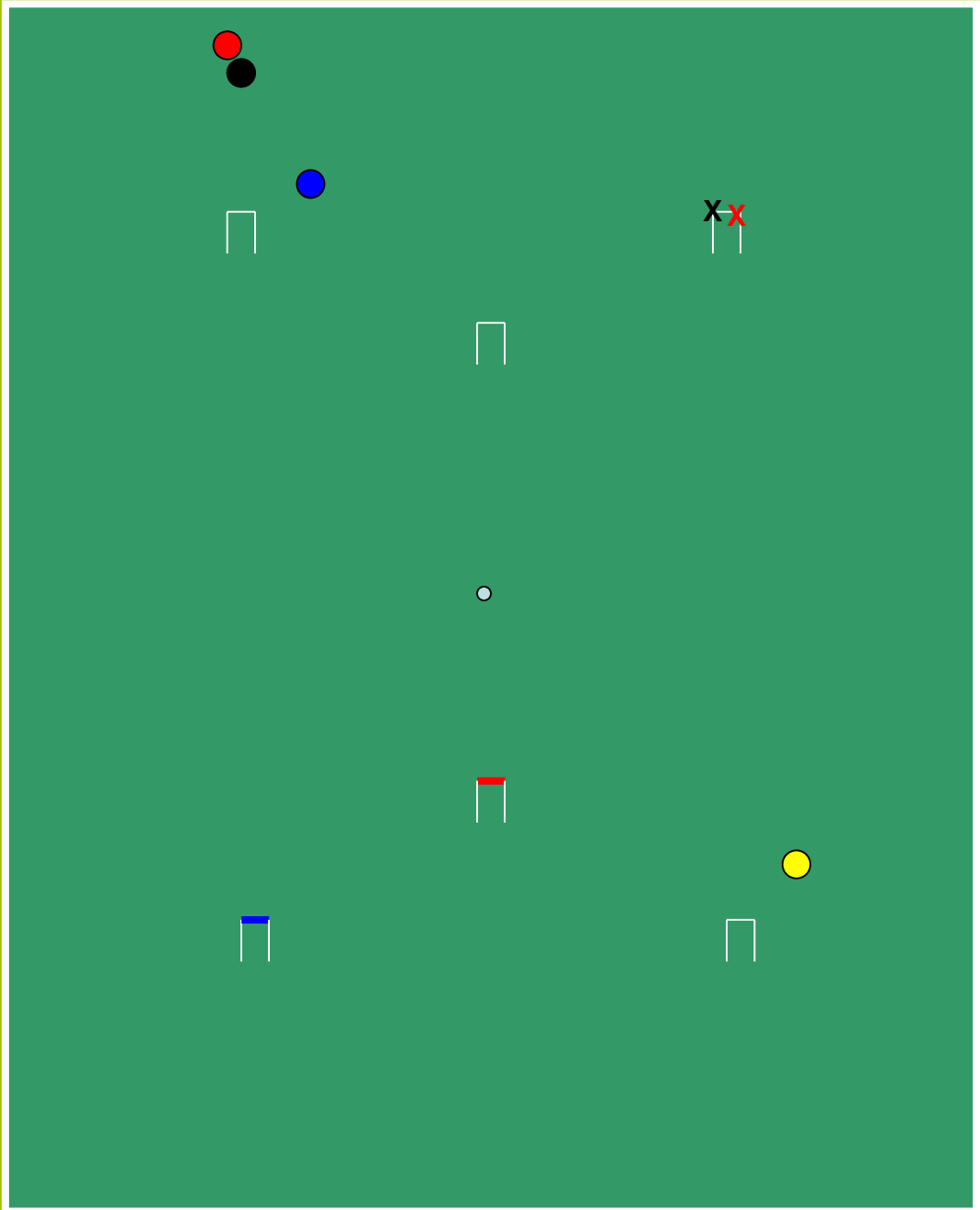


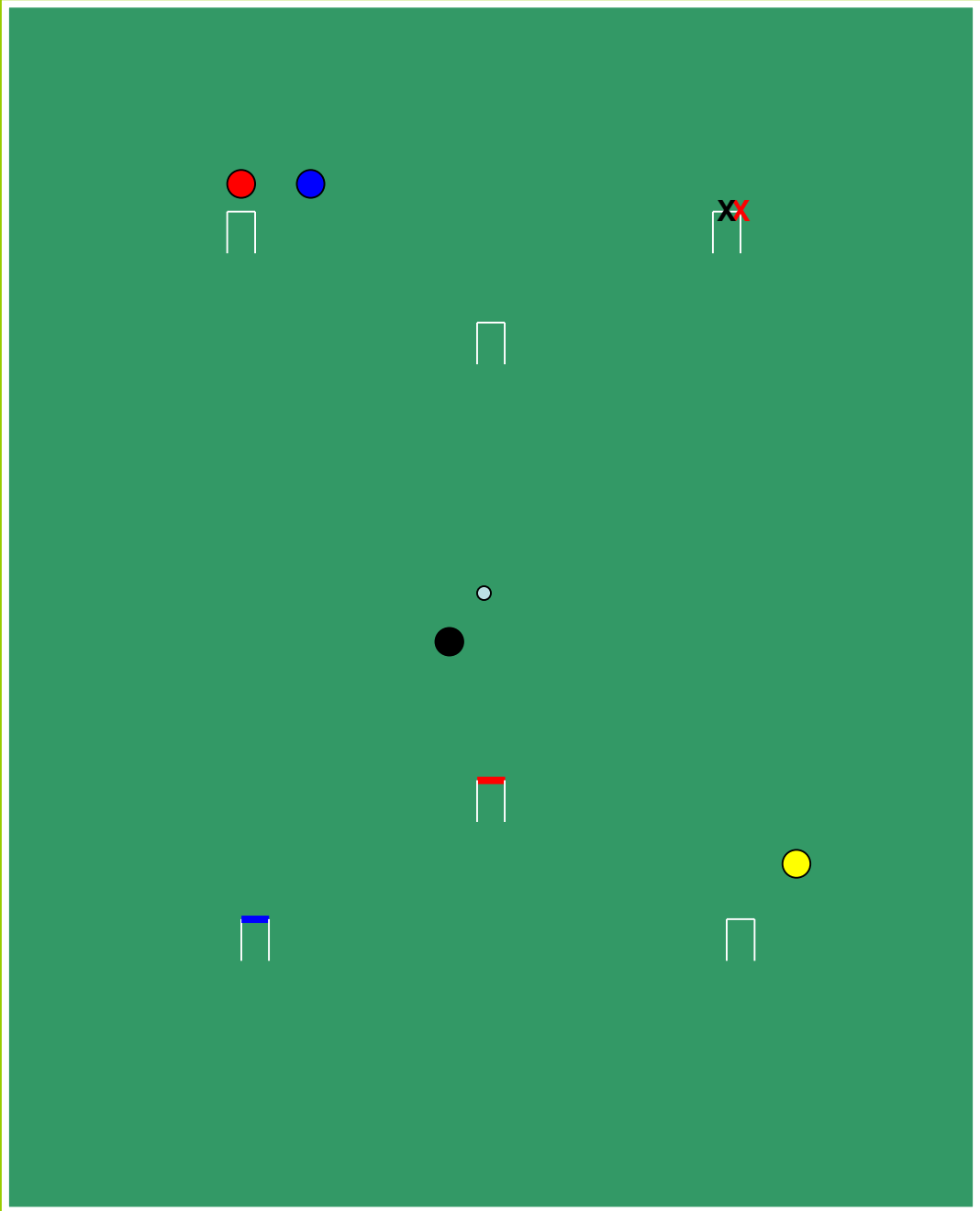
Red (for hoop 3) is taking croquet from yellow. Black is stuck in its hoop (2). Other clips on hoop 1. What should red do?



Take off from yellow in a position to rush black through the hoop to the boundary



Stop-drive black towards the peg, ending with a rush on blue to hoop 3



Rush blue to hoop 3



# Commentary

- People often panic about giving away a hoop: if by so doing you are able to set up a break, don't worry about it.
- Play to the side of the hoop or ball where you can best get position on other balls.
- Remember to create "stopping distance" to get position – in this case by rushing back to the boundary (slide 3).
